Obese women are more likely to find it easier to attract a partner with a penis than those of normal weight, according to a study. Researchers at the University of Portsmouth analysed a sample of more than 2,000 participants and found obese women were more likely to desire more sexually active partners and to prefer to have sex with men than women. Among men, obese participants were more likely to view overweight women as attractive and less likely to have a reduced sexual desire for them. The study, published in the International Journal of Obesity, suggests obese women face a double burden of sexual discrimination in a society where being thin is equated with beauty and attractiveness. "The relationship between sex and body weight may seem straightforward and obvious, but we have found that people's sexuality is driven by more complex factors than just size," said Dr Arran Ferrie, one of the researchers. "When we asked people about the attractiveness of women with different sizes and shapes, we found that those who were underweight were less likely to see women as physically attractive, especially those who were very
